People helping establish places and positions for workers to go have been traveling extensively throughout this year, building relationships with the Body of Christ in various nations and, through prayer and sharing, seeing bridges built which are facilitating the Chinese Church in their quest to send believers to the neediest places with the message of salvation.

Of particular interest at the moment, and something we ask prayer for, is the completion of a tremendous teaching series in Mandarin Chinese, which deals with every aspect of equipping believers for missionary service. This series, consisting of hundreds of hours of outstanding teaching, has been made with house church representatives inside China overseeing the entire process. Those close to the project are excited about the impact the teaching will make, as it is unlike anything else available up to this time.
